### **Changes to Metro Tasmania services for Term 1, 2019**

Some bus routes and timetables are changing in southern Tasmania as a result of the bus network review undertaken by the Department of State Growth (DSG), the contract holder for all public transport services in Tasmania.

The changes involve both school bus and general access services across all passenger transport operators, including Metro, and are expected to be introduced on **Sunday 20 January 2019**.

As contracted service providers, we will be working to support the Tasmanian travelling public to prepare for this change and would appreciate any assistance you could render in communicating details to your school community.

### **SUMMARY OF CHANGES TO METRO SERVICES FOR TERM 1, 2019**

- Timetables for most Channel services operated by Metro on **Routes 411 to 417** will change.
- **Route 418** from Cygnet to Hobart via Nicholls Rivulet will be withdrawn. Cygnet services will now be provided exclusively by Tassielink Transit and will travel via Huonville.
- **Route 429** from Huntingfield to Hobart City via Summerleas and Taroona will change. All Route 429 services will now commence from Summerleas. Students living in Huntingfield and travelling to Guilford Young College should instead use Routes 412 to 417, which will continue to service the existing Huntingfield stop.
- **Route 605** to/from Tranmere **will be re-routed** to travel Tranmere > Shoreline > Clarence St > Rosny Park > Tasman Bridge > Liverpool St > Elizabeth St (Limited Stops) > New Town Rd (Limited Stops) > Main Rd (Limited Stops) to Glenorchy.
- Timetables for Opossum Bay services on **Routes X44 and 646** will change.
- **Route X45** from Clifton Beach and Cremorne to Hobart City is being withdrawn and replaced by **Route 646**.
- **Route 646** will now travel via Clifton Beach Terminus, in addition to Cremorne.
