



University programs for college students

The University of Tasmania - among the top two per cent of the world's universities* - offers a range of opportunities for Guilford Young College students to take part in university studies and experiences while at college. Students may commence in study that may contribute to a degree, and will prepare them for tertiary education. Students have access to university facilities, lecturers and resources.

HIGH ACHIEVER PROGRAM

Students within the High Achiever Program not only receive academic challenges and university experience, they also receive subsidised course costs, credit towards a degree, units to count towards their ATAR score and access to facilities and support services.

Subjects range from discipline specific such as mathematics, Indigenous Australian history or Latin to general study skills such as critical and creative thinking.

Any successfully completed units may be credited towards a relevant degree when the student enrolls at the University of Tasmania. This allows them to either accelerate through their degree or take on additional subjects and extend their study program.

To qualify for this program, students need to demonstrate very high levels of academic performance. For example, they would normally be expected to be enrolled in Year 12 and have completed three or more Level 3 subjects in Year 11 with Exceptional Achievement awarded.

Applications open in September and close in December. When applications are open visit the UTAS website www.utas.edu.au/cupp to find an application for admission form, and statement of achievement to download and send to the university.
